The Route

The route doesn't cross any main roads and all answers can be seen from the specified sidewalk without entering private property (sometimes you may have to look across the road, but you shouldn't need to walk over except as instructed).

Start at the main school entrance on Hiawatha on the school side of the road. Head North then turn Right onto Fairford.

CROSS Ashdale and turn Right and walk down the East (left) side. Turn Left onto Gerrard.

CROSS Craven.

CROSS Rhodes and turn Left, heading up the East (right) side of Rhodes.

CROSS Fairford. At the trainline, turn Left along the path and follow it to Ashdale. Turn Left and go down the steps to Ashdale, then continue on the West (right) side.

CROSS Fairford and turn right, heading along the Kindergarten fence again.

CROSS Hiawatha.

CROSS Fairford and continue North up Woodfield on the East (Right hand) side.

CROSS Woodfield and head West along the South (left hand) of Walpole.

CROSS Highfield.

CROSS Glenside. Turn left down Redwood, staying on the East (left hand) side. Turn Left onto Gerrard at the bottom.

CROSS Glenside.

CROSS Highfield.

CROSS Woodfield.

CROSS Hiawatha and return to the school gates up the East (right hand) sidewalk

Look around as you walk. You'll see lots of interesting things on houses and stores, in yards and on the sidewalk. Don't forget to look across the street too. If you can't see something, keep going. Once you find another answer, you'll know you missed one. Some of the questions tell you exactly where to look!
