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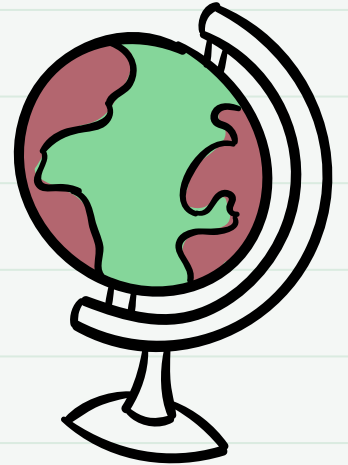

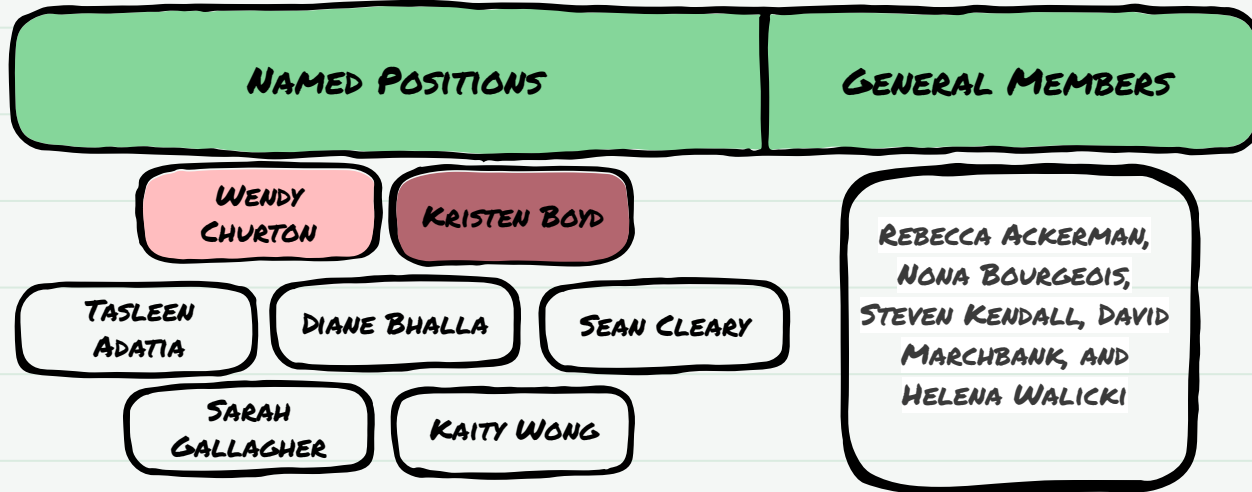
INTRODUCTION

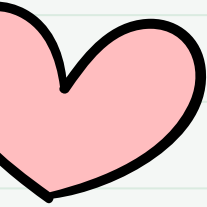
We are parents and caregivers who dedicate our time and efforts to represent all families and students within our school community.

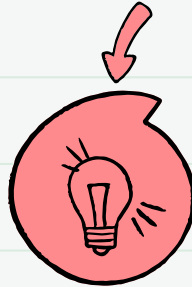


HOW THE EVENTS BREAKDOWN



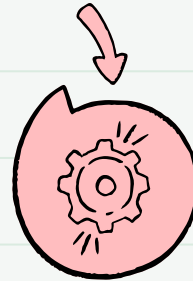
14 - COMMUNITY BUILDING

Defined as events that were hosted without any cost to the school community to participate.



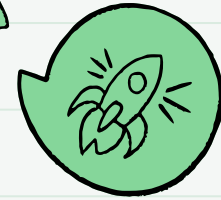
5 - PARENT/ CAREGIVER

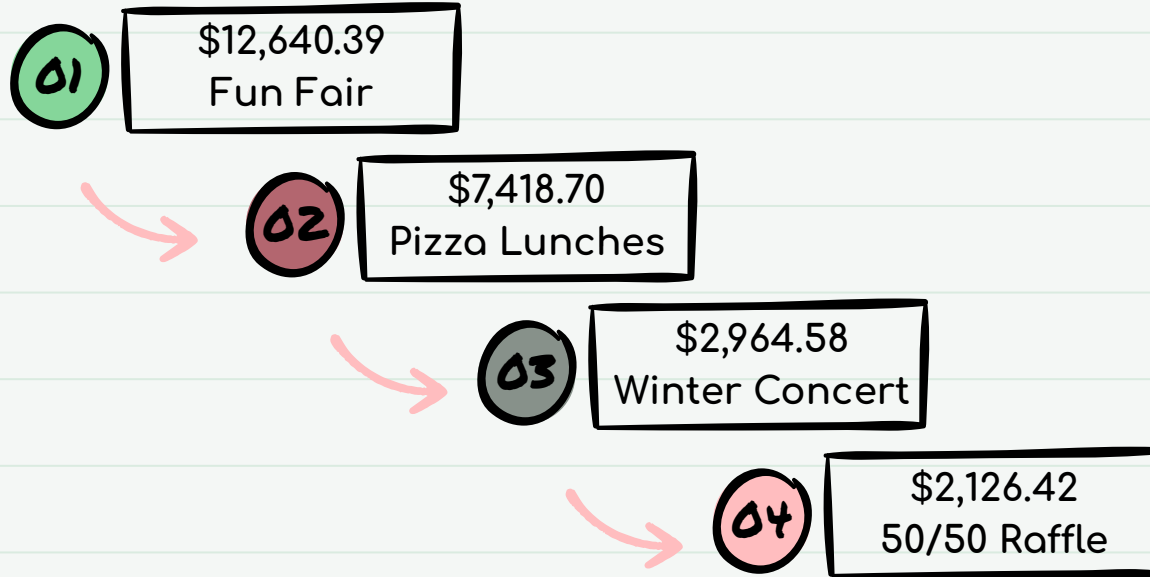

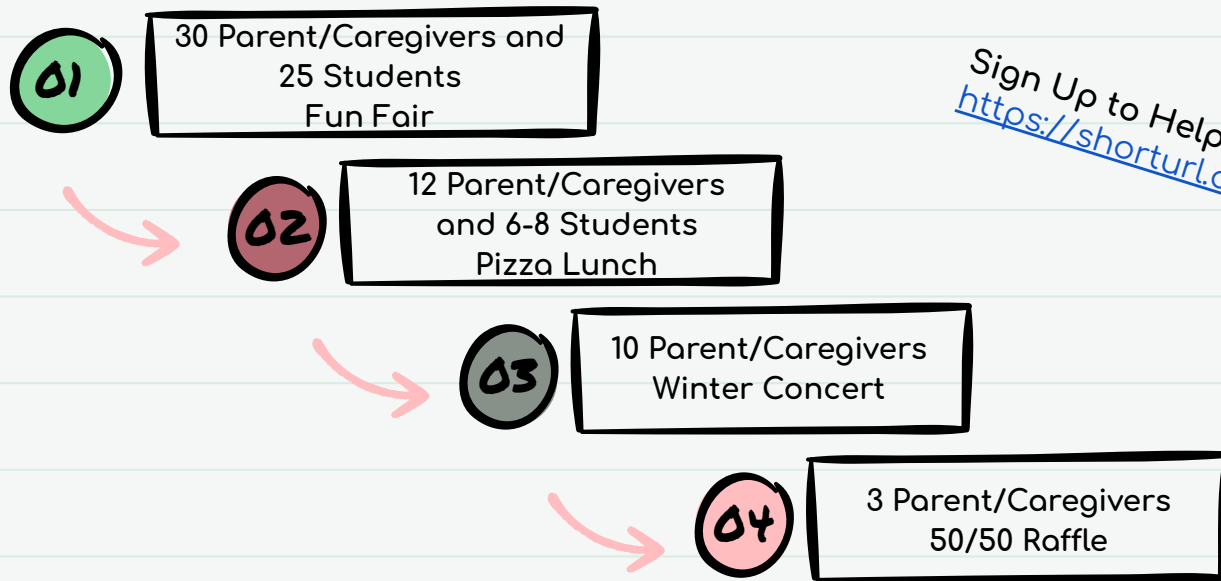

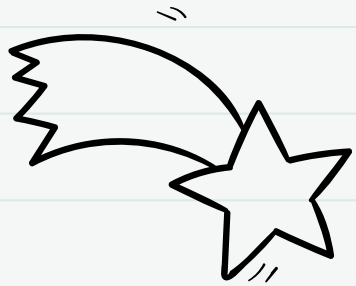


Digital Improvements

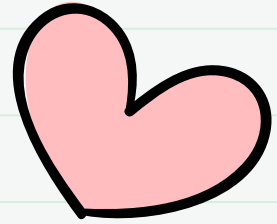
- Purchased two square devices for accepting debit and credit card payments at events.

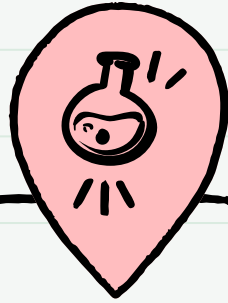


EQUITY

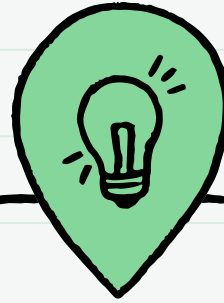
